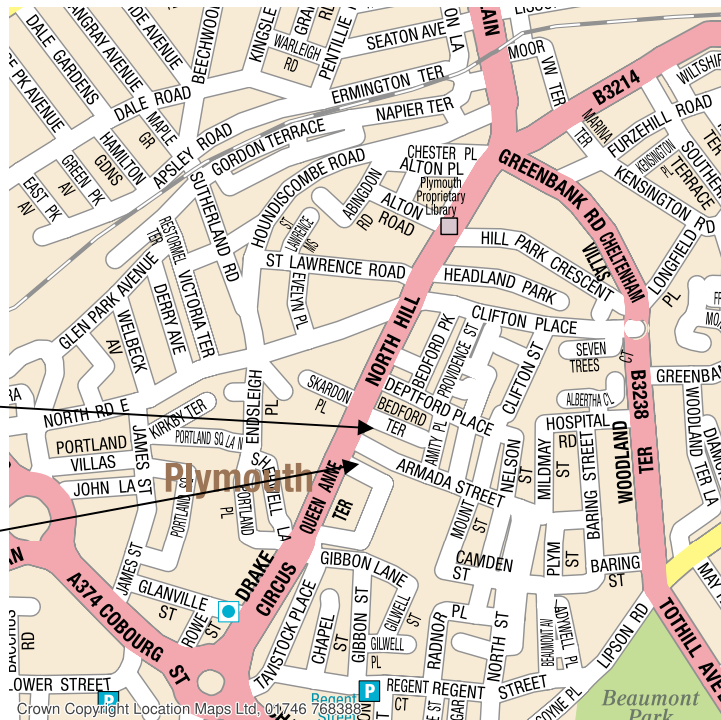

Directions

By road

From outside Plymouth, turn off the A38 north of Plymouth, at the junction signposted to Tavistock, Plymouth (City Centre) and Mutley. Take the exit from the roundabout signposted to Mutley (B3250). This leads after about 1.5 miles to North Hill. Turn right into North Road East. Then turn first left into a Pay & Display car park. The tribunal's hearing room can then be reached on foot by taking the North Hill exit from the car park and turning left (uphill) - the tribunal building is the first on the left, up several steps. Wheelchair access is from the right hand side of the private car park at the rear of the building, via a level pathway around to the North Hill entrance. For those with internet access, help with planning a car journey is available at www.transportdirect.info

Parking: The Pay & Display car park referred to above usually has spaces available, including three disabled users parking spaces. The tribunal has one accessible parking space in the private rear car park that can be made available on request to disabled visitors.
